

## Categorization of works in the Journal Obrazovanjeodraslih/Adult Education

Scientific papers are reviewed by at least two reviewers in the relevant scientific field and determine the category of the article. The UDC number is assigned by y library classification specialist.

## Types of papers

**Original scientific paper** – A scientific article which contains unpublished and new results of theoretical considerations and practical research is in its complete form categorized as an original scientific paper. It is characterized as original work when it contributes to a particular scientific issue or its understanding and when it describes new results of theoretical and/or empirical research in a field. The paper is written in a way that enables any expert working in the same field to replicate the research design, based on given information, and to achieve the described results with equal accuracy or within the margins of error stated by the author, or to replicate the author's observations, theoretical statements or concepts he/she questions in new conditions, with new insights related to the same phenomenon.

**Review paper** – Scientific article containing original, concise and critical review of a theoretical field or practical research in which the author him/herself actively and critically participates. In the paper the role of author's original contribution, in relation to previously published works, should be emphasized, and an overview of these works should be included. Such work is categorized as a review scientific paper. It contains a complete account of the state of a particular theoretical field or its application. Author provides his/her own critical review and evaluation and must state information on all published works that were used as the starting point for his/her work.

**Professional paper** – Contains useful contributions for improvement of practice in a particular field but does not give any original contribution to scientific knowledge. This category may include research from practice (case studies, evaluative studies, etc.), reviewed professional papers or presentations from experts' meetings.

Other uncategorized papers such as reviews, reports and documents are published in a dedicated section of the journal.
